ABSTRACT

Postcards collected by Rose Standish Nichols depicting art, architecture, landscape and garden design, building interiors, tourist images, and other subjects. A small percentage of the postcards feature personal messages by or to Rose Standish Nichols.

ARRANGEMENT AND PROCESSING NOTE

In 2004-2005, Rae Russell performed the initial processing of Rose Standish Nichols' postcard collection. The postcards were found in a bag with no discernible order except that some postcards were bundled together. Presuming the bundles were created by Rose Standish Nichols, the processors kept them intact. They now form clusters A through R. In September of 2007, several blank postcards that were found with the Nichols family papers were also added to the postcard collection, including clusters Q and R.

Rae Russell devised category headings for the postcards to improve searching capabilities. These headings include Architecture/Doorways, Architecture, Ceramics, Decorative Objects, Engraving, Etching, Interiors, Interiors/Fireplaces, Landscape/Garden Design, Manuscript, Metalwork, Miscellaneous, Mosaics, Native American Art, Painting, Scenic Views, Sculpture, Ships, Textiles, Tourist Images, and Woodcuts. All of the postcards, whether in clusters or not, were assigned category headings. Postcards that were not part of clusters were arranged according to their category. Russell created an Excel spreadsheet listing all of the postcards and noting their date, country, and whether there was any writing on the card.

In September of 2007, Carrie Supple assigned individual numbers to each postcard, using the prefix "PC1" before each number to signify Postcard Collection 1. Postcards were marked with their number in pencil. Supple physically arranged the postcards in the order that they appeared on Russell's list; edited the descriptions of the non-clustered postcards; re-housed the collection into three boxes and one oversize box; and edited the Excel spreadsheet into a finding aid.

SEPARATION REPORT

Thirteen photographs found with the postcard collection were removed to the Nichols Family Photograph Collection (Photo. Coll. 1) in September 2007. They are photographs: 1.203, 1.204, 1.245, 1.253a, 1.253b, 1.256, 1.258, 1.259, 1.263, 1.270, 1.271, 1.274, and 1.275.
